

Outreach Angels is a Non-Profit organisation, founded with the aim of providing aid to those in need. In order to effectively provide this support, funds are required. These funds will be used for the following:

- Space rent for storage unit, holding items in advance of distribution
- Liability Insurance
- Food & Drinks for the vulnerable
- Covering costs that volunteers may incur as a direct result of an activity undertaken for the organisation in exceptional circumstances
- Equipment in order to operate
- Other miscellaneous items or occasional services that further enable the organisation to provide aid

Outreach Angels have defined funding routes but also accept donations; the organisation does not receive donations in exchange for explicit promotion of the donor, but reserves the right to express gratitude through various forms of media.

UK fundraising practice must follow the relevant legislation – set out in the Charities Acts, other relevant legislation and local government by-laws. Fundraising is regulated in England and Wales by the Fundraising Regulator which holds the Code of Fundraising Practice for the UK and which makes sure all fundraising is legal, open, honest and accountable. Outreach Angels operates a transparency policy and is willing to produce financial records on demand to provide clarification with regard to funding routes and spending.

Outreach Angels does not aim to generate significant funds, or to receive donations in excess of what is required to operate in a reasonable manner. Therefore, the organisation launches fundraising campaigns only when there is a recognised need for funds to continue to operate. Excessive fundraising should be discouraged.

Outreach Angels encourages members of the public to interact with the organisation, and will gratefully accept donations, but these donations should be made with a purpose in mind. The organisation will discourage un-allocated donations, and will where possible consult with the donor to identify a worthwhile product/service to use the funds for before accepting the donation.
